

Instructions

1. To qualify for a Concord College license plate you must be a graduate, or friend of Concord College (University).
2. The vehicle must have a West Virginia title and license plate in the name of the applicant before a special plate can be issued.
3. The current license plate must be returned to the Division of Motor Vehicles after the special plate is received. After issuance of the special plate, the exchanged plate is canceled and cannot be transferred to another vehicle. There are no refunds.
4. Please send the application with payment to the address listed below, with payment made to Concord University. Please include your personal property tax receipt or an affidavit from the assessor, if your registration is expiring within 60 days of your application.
