

Instructions

1. To qualify for a WV Deputy Sheriff's Association license plate you must be an active member of the West Virginia Deputy Sheriff's Association (WVDSA).
2. The vehicle must be Class A, have a WV title, and WV license plate in the name of the applicant before a special plate can be issued.
3. The current license plate must be returned to the Division of Motor Vehicles after the special plate is received. After issuance of the special plate, the exchanged plate is canceled and cannot be transferred to another vehicle. There are no refunds.
4. Send the application and correct fees (as outlined below) via check or money order payable to WVDSA License Plate at the address listed below. Please include your personal property tax receipt or an affidavit from the assessor, if your registration is expiring within 60 days of your application.
