A policy of bodily injury liability and property damage liability insuring said dealership (or any other person, as insured, operating any vehicle owned by said dealership with the express or implied permission of said dealership) against loss from liability imposed by law damages arising from the ownership, operation, maintenance or use of such vehicle (subject to minimum limits, exclusive of interest and cost) with respect to such vehicle as follows:

Twenty thousand dollars because of bodily injury to or death of one person in one accident (subject to said limit for one person), forty thousand dollars because of bodily injury to or death of two or more persons in any accident, and ten thousand dollars because of injury to or property damage sustained by others in any one accident.

Note: Dealers not subject to liability policy requirements due to the terminology “vehicle” must have a general liability policy in the amount of fifty thousand dollars from damages arising from the ownership of the dealership named herein.

*If the policy described has been cancelled by either the insurer or the insured, the insurer shall immediately notify the West Virginia Division of Motor Vehicles of such cancellation in writing at its Charleston office.*

*I hereby state, under penalty of false swearing and penalties outlined in the West Virginia Motor Vehicle Laws Chapter 17 that there is in effect a liability policy on the described business in accordance with the provisions of the West Virginia Motor Vehicle Laws.*
