

Instructions

1. To qualify for a Benevolent Protective Order of Elks license plate you must be a lodge member or the spouse of a member of the Benevolent Protective Order of Elks.
2. The vehicle must have a West Virginia title and license plate in the name of the applicant before a special plate can be issued.
3. The current license plate must be returned to the Division of Motor Vehicles after the special plate is received. After issuance of the special plate, the exchanged plate is canceled and cannot be transferred to another vehicle. There are no refunds.
4. Send the application and correct fees (as outlined below) via check or money order payable to Charleston Elks at the address listed below. Please include your personal property tax receipt or an affidavit from the assessor, if your registration is expiring within 60 days of your application.
