WVPEDTA E-ZPassSM Customer Agreement

Terms and Conditions

These Terms and Conditions, together with your application, constitute your WVPEDTA E-ZPasssM Agreement. Please read it carefully and keep it for your records. When you open an account and your tag is used, you agree to the following:

Failure to comply with this Agreement may result in termination of your account. Failure to pay tolls may result in additional penalties provided for by law including termination of your account.

2) Tag Use

a) Your WVPEDTA E-ZPassSM tag is transferable between vehicles of the same WVPEDTA vehicle class.

b) Your WVPEDTA E-ZPasssM tag is good wherever you see the E-ZPasssM logo.

- c) You must comply with all applicable traffic laws, regulations, signs, signals, and directions of participating roadways.
- d) As you approach and pass through a toll lane, you will under no circumstances exceed a speed of 5 miles per hour.

- e) You may not assign the obligations or benefits of this Agreement.

 f) The application establishes your WVPEDTA E-ZPasssM account with the West Virginia Parkways Authority. In the event that the WVPEDTA E-ZPasssM tag(s) is used at another E-ZPasssM toll facility you authorize WVPEDTA to debit your WVPEDTA E-ZPasssM account to pay for that toll.

 g) When you use your WVPEDTA E-ZPasssM tag, a non-refundable toll will be charged to your WVPEDTA E-ZPasssM account.

3) Your Account

If you are a check/cash customer, you a) Prepaid toll. must maintain a prepaid toll amount with us to cover applicable toll charges. Tolls are deducted from your account each time the WVPEDTA E-ZPass tag

is used. b) Account balances. No interest will be paid on cash balances in your account.

- c) Replenishment, Periodically your toll use will be reviewed. If your monthly activity is above or below your current monthly payment, your minimum monthly payment will be adjusted accordingly. You will be notified of any changes to your account. Details pertaining to your account will be provided with
- e) A minimum charge of \$100.00 per month has been set for all charge accounts. Any account not averaging \$100.00 per month will be notified for

cancellation.

4) Account Status

You will receive a statement summarizing all -transactions once per month.

Method of Payment: Account replenishment must occur when your prepaid toll amount decreases to or below the threshold amount specific to the method of payment you selected. You can replenish your account in one of the following ways:

a) Credit Card

b) Check /Cash - Checks should be made payable to West Virginia Parkways Authority. A returned check fee of \$25 will be charged for each check returned to us. Cash payments must be made in U.S. dollars in person at the WVPEDTA Customer Service Center. See Section 14 for mailing address information, DO NOT SEND CASH IN THE MAIL.

Violations

Improper use of your WVPEDTA E-ZPassSM tags, improper speeds through toll lanes or failure to pay the proper toll may result in an administrative fee and/or loss of tag privilege. The administrative fee will be in addition to the toll amount and may be up to \$25 per occurrence.

7) Lost/Stolen or Defective Tags

You will not be liable for unauthorized tag(s) usage that occurs after we receive written notice from you via mail or fax (304-926-3748). You will be liable for toll charges incurred prior to notification. Please contact the WVPEDTA Customer Service Center if you wish to replace your tag(s). Defective tag(s): If your WVPEDTA E-ZPasss tag(s) is non-operational for reasons other than abuse or improper use, and the tag(s) is returned to us, we will replace it at no charge to you. Otherwise, you will pay \$25 to replace the tag(s). If your tag is damaged due to defacement you will pay \$25.

8) Disclaimer

To the extent permitted by law, we expressly disclaim, any representation or warranty, expressed or implied, relating to the WVPEDTA E-ZPasss tag including without limitation, any implied or expressed warranty of merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, or conformity to models or samples. Nor are we liable for any third party action taken by reason of your use or display of the WVPEDTA E-ZPass tag. You agree to indemnify us and hold us harmless from and against any and all damage, loss, cost, expense, or liability relating to, arising from, or as a result of the use or performance of the WVPEDTA E-ZPassSM tag.

9) Termination

You may terminate this Agreement at any time by returning your transponder to the address on the front label of your transponder.

You agree to pay all costs, including attorney's fees, incurred by us to collect any monies due under the terms of this Agreement.

11) Modification

We may change the Terms and Conditions at anytime. You will be bound by any revised Terms and Conditions provided with your account statement (consistent with the form of statement requested upon application). First use of tag after effective date of new Terms and Conditions will constitute your acceptance. A copy of the revised Terms and Conditions will be mailed to you upon request. The invalidity of any term or terms of this Agreement shall not affect any other term of this Agreement, which shall remain in full force and effect. You agree to inform us, in writing, of any changes to the information provided by you in your WVPEDTA E-ZPassSM application, such as:

Interior Transponder Mounting Instructions

for car interior on windshield

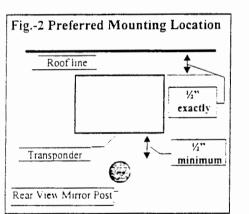
For proper operation, make sure the transponder is mounted as follows:

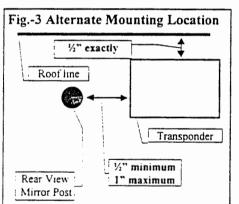
- 1. Identify the front face of the transponder. It displays your agency label and two upward-pointing arrows. (Fig.-1) This side faces the driver with the arrows pointing toward the roof of your vehicle.
- Identify the position in your vehicle in which the transponder will be mounted. The preferred location is between the exposed edge of the windshield (roofline) and the rear view mirror post—as long as the clearances in Fig.-2 can be maintained. If there is insufficient room, the alternate location shown in Fig.-3 must be used.
- 3. Having determined the mounting position in your vehicle, clean the inside surface of that section of the windshield if necessary. Now carefully remove the red protective backing from the Dual LockTM mounting strips on the rear of the transponder as shown in Fig. 4 and firmly press the rear of the transponder against the glass. Maintain the pressure for about 15 seconds to achieve a good bond.

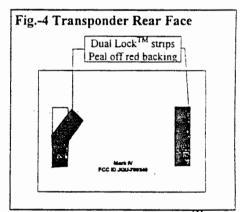
Fig.-1 Transponder Front Face

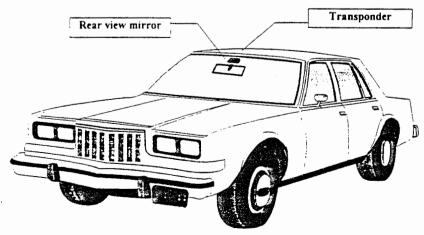
Agency label faces driver







The transponder may be removed by lifting any one corner with sufficient pressure to separate the Dual LockTM strips. Do not remove the Dual LockTM from the windshield and reuse it; obtain new strips from your service center if necessary.

Interior Transponder Mounting Instructions For Trucks and commercial Vehicles

For proper operation, make sure the transponder is mounted as follows:

For vehicles without a center windshield divider-post:

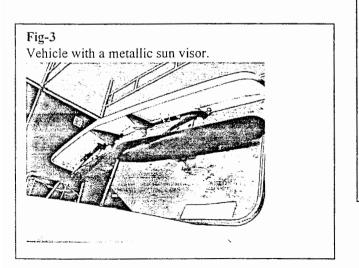
Transponder (either IAG flat pack or FUSION) should be mounted with its base 1 inch above the bottom and along the center line of the windshield. The transponder must not be permanently obscured by the windshield wiper blade(s) in either a parked or operating position. If the wipers do cover the transponder, (in the ideal center position) it may be moved up to 2 inches in any direction to try and avoid this situation.

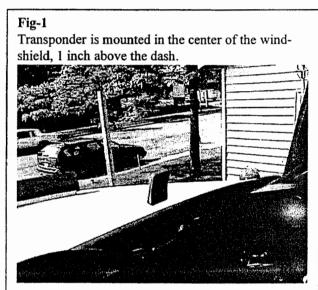
For vehicles with a center windshield divider-post:

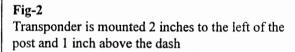
Mount the transponder 2 inches to the LEFT of the divider-post and 1 inch above the bottom of the windshield. As above, wiper blades must not obscure the transponder. If wipers are a problem, the transponder may be mounted to the RIGHT of the divider-post and up to 3 inches from the bottom of the windshield. The transponder should NOT be mounted closer than 2 inches from the divider-post.

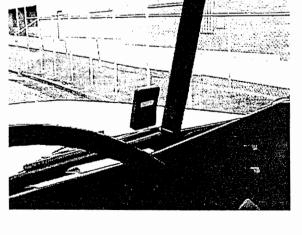
Vehicles with metallic sun visors:

The interior transponder may NOT be used with vehicles that incorporate a **metallic** sun visor as it has an excessive shielding effect. Exterior transponders must be considered in this case.

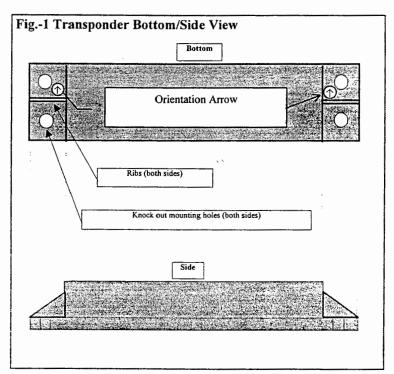
Exterior Transponder Mounting Instructions

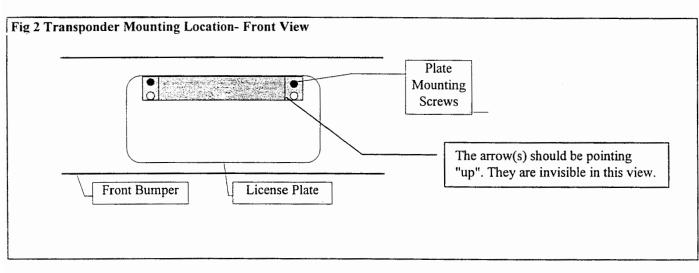
for use in an overhead antenna application

For proper operation, make sure the transponder is mounted as follows:

Identify the transponder bottom (or rear) face. It contains orientation symbols (arrows) next to the mounting holes. Agency or customer specific labels may be present on any face. (See Figs 1,2)

- The transponder must be fastened to the front license plate using the top mounting screws.
- Fasten the transponder with the existing license plate screws using the knock out holes in the case. Ensure that the transponder is oriented as in Fig 2.
