- Adam Gillispie visited Indiana to see some concrete work. Donald McNutt of the American Concrete Pipe Association said they sent in some comments regarding this MP. In 3.2 they mention QCAST, an ANSI-accredited program and he wanted to vouch for it.
- Adam mentioned 4.3, that it deals with form removal. Discussion ensued mostly between Adam and Mr. McNutt regarding cylinders, the number of each done per mix design and their testing for strength. Andrew Thaxton, Mike Mance and Josh Beakley (VP Engineering at ASPI) further commented.
- Donald McNutt had marked out a section in 4.3.2 regarding dry cast and Adam wondered why; he said it was because typically yield tests and unit weight are not done on dry cast products.
- 4.5.4 Adam mentioned they removed a statement about broadcast boxes, which Adam said can be in different sizes.
- 5.2. in regards to trial fitting: Adam said he likes their trial fitting procedure. They recently learned about doing this horizontally and it has worked out well.
