**SUBJECT: POLICE AGENCY SIGNS**

---

The purpose of installing the **POLICE AGENCY DIRECTIONAL** signs is to advise unfamiliar motorists that they are approaching the immediate area of a driver testing facility. Since driver testing is only performed by the West Virginia Division of Public Safety, only State Police Offices will be eligible for such signing.

The subject signs:

1. Shall not be installed on Interstate Highways or other fully controlled access expressways.
2. Should not be installed, if the State Police facility is visible from the highway and is easily identified by approaching motorists.
3. Should be considered for installation only if specifically requested by the State Police.
4. Shall only be installed on the nearest US or WV numbered Route and its intersection or driveway leading directly to the facility.

When installing signs for a State Police Office, the sign assembly shall consist of a blue and white STATE POLICE symbol and an accompanying Directional Arrow.
